Frequently Asked Questions

What is Opt-Out Aggregation?

- Buying Group that pools together usage for best price
- Eligible customers can sign up to be Included
- Community controls buying group when switching suppliers
- No fee to opt-out

What Are Electric Aggregation Benefits?

- Fixed Price Options that <u>renew at fixed prices</u>
- Price Buying Leverage
- Best Combination of Term, Service & Pricing Available

How Will I Be Billed?

- Meter Reads & Billing by Local Utility
- New Supplier Charge Included on Bill
- Payments Made to Local Utility
- Budget Billing Option Availability Continues for Ohio Edison portion
- Automatic Payment Option Availability Continues
- Itemization of Supplier's Deregulated Charges

Why has the rate gone up so much?

- Transmission capacity rates have gone from \$29 to \$270/MW-Day
- The Ohio Edison Price to Compare is about 8.1 cents/kWh and is expected to be about 10.2 cents/kWh in June 2025.

Was I Able to Vote For Opt-out Aggregation?

 Yes, the Issue passed on the November 2008 ballot

Who is Eligible to Participate?

 Residential and Commercial Accounts under 700,000 kWh per year in participating townships

Who is Not Eligible to Automatically Participate in opt-out aggregation?

- PIPP Customers
- Delinquent Bill Payees
- Account Holders Outside Community Limits
- Customers Under Contract with third Party Supplier; however They Can Opt-In by Calling Program Supplier
- Commercial Accounts in Community greater than 200 kW Demand

What if I'm Moving into The Community?

- May Not Receive Program Offer Mailing
- Need to Contact Supplier
- Need to Know Terms of Any Existing Contracts

What if I'm Moving out of The Community?

- May Opt-Out Free If Moving Out of the Community
- May Leave Any Other Time Depending on Supplier Contract May be Charged a Termination Fee

How Does the Energy Harbor-Vistra merger announcement effect me?

 Energy Harbor is selling the business to Vistra, but the current price, term and conditions will be honored. The name Dynegy will be used after March 2025.
